Six- Color "Split" Primary Mixing Chart for Watercolors with Libby Fife of Valley Springs

In this one-day class you will learn to make a version of a "split" primary color chart that uses both a cool and warm version of each of the three primary colors in your watercolor kit. You'll learn how to mix a variety of primary and secondary colors as well as some lovely grays and browns (neutrals). The class is designed for beginning watercolorists who are interested in the concept of creating a limited palette to use as a guide in painting or sketching. Limited palettes can help to unify your sketches, express a particular mood or highlight a particular subject, teach you about your paint properties, and are a useful compositional tool. The following colors are suggested and supply a warm and cool color of each hue. Town Hall Arts also sells a beginner's kit of watercolor cakes which you may use.

### Cool/Warm:

\* Ultramarine blue/Phthalo blue; cobalt blue, cerulean blue are OK for warm alternate colors

\* Cad red light or pyrole red/quin rose/magenta or Alizarin perm; other versions of warm or cool reds are also acceptable

\* Azo or cad yellow light/ cad yellow medium; other versions of cool and warm yellows are also acceptable.

\* Mat board about 8x10 available from Susie/Larry

\* Ruler, black Sharpie, pencil

- \* Round or flat wash brush-enough to carry a good water and pigment load
- \* palette
- \* Paper towels/water container

Cost of instruction is \$15 with an additional \$2 classroom fee.



### Watercolor

Watercolor on Japanese Masa Paper with Martha Wallace

Experience watercolor on this unique Japanese paper in a two-day workshop with well-known foothill watercolor teacher Martha Wallace

of Avery. You may need beginning-intermediate level of drawing and watercolor experience to make the most of this workshop. Cost is \$80 for workshop plus \$4



classroom fee. You will need to provide your own paper and Yes glue (available for purchase. )

#### Supply List:

WATERCOLORS: Martha uses Daniel Smith watercolors, but any good quality w/c are fine. Colors are as follows: aureolin, cobalt blue, indathrone, new gamboge, organic vermillion, quinacridone pink, quinacridone sienna, rose of ultramarine, quinacridone coral, quinacridone gold, ultramarine turquoise, and ultramarine blue.

<u>BRUSHES</u>: Martha uses good synthetic bushes. Recommended sizes: 1" and or 2" flat brush, rounds #6, #8, #12, brush, #3 rigger, #2 fan brush.

PALETTE: John Pike watercolor palette or any that you may have with a large mixing area

PAPER: 140 lb. Arches cold press w/c paper full sheet, 2 full sheets masa paper.

<u>MISCELLANEOUS STUFF</u>: Drawing pencils, eraser, sketch tablet, drawing board, archival glue (Yes Glue diluted 2/3 glue to 1/3 water), small brayer or rolling pin, roll of paper towels.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: We will be concentrating on simple shaped fruits and vegetables (pears, apples, peppers, etc.) and large simple shaped flowers (tulips, iris, water lilies, etc.) Bring photos of both if you have some, otherwise I will have an assortment of them.

*Improve Your Painting with award-winning pastel and oil painter Sunny Sorensen of Hathaway Pines* 

In this six-week class, we'll get to the core of what really makes a painting work and develop techniques to make this happen. The class is designed to help take the frustration out of creating and let you have some fun in the process. Expect an enlightening and exciting experience with an assortment of mediums. Along with other guidelines, you will learn how one rule of composition will move you toward painting with a solid design right from the beginning. It will be painless. Class is geared to motivated beginning and intermediate painters and includes homework.

Class size limit: 8. Deposit of \$35 required to hold your place. Cost is \$70 plus \$12 classroom fee.

Drawing and Painting the Nude with Sunny Sorensen This spirited life drawing session has become more instructional by popular demand, and is geared toward those who want to improve their observational and drawing skills. Students will be able to explore various techniques for loosening up. Emphasis is on gesture, correct measurement,



line quality, form and cast shadows, creating volume, and placement of the form. Drawing materials include vine or hard charcoal, Conte crayon, graphite, kneadable eraser, chamois, and a 18x24 newsprint pad. Hour long poses accommodate painting for those with painting skills. Now in its fourth year, this class has been very popular and fills up quickly. Class size is limited to 8. Class is suitable for beginning and intermediate life drawers.

Sunny has a BA in Studio Art from UC Davis. Trained in figurative painting and ceramic sculpture she studied with Wayne Thiebaud, Roland Petersen, and Bob Arneson. In addition she has taken several workshops in plein air painting, and conducts workshops in California and Mexico.

Wet-into-Wet Transparent Watercolor Landscape Workshop with Alvin Joe of Foster City



Award-winning watercolorist Alvin Joe will conduct this two-day landscape workshop at Atelier Copper. A career artist with over 35 years in advertising design and illustration, Alvin has won numerous awards and recognitions in the San Francisco Bay Area. Alvin is a signature member of the California Watercolor Association and has two of his paintings published in

Splash 10.

Students will work from photographs provided by the instructor the first day and outside on Saturday. Alvin encourages students to bring a sack lunch so that they may spend as much time as possible on their project. Suggested supply list for beginners: Arches cold press 11x15 watercolor paper or 10x14 block, #4 and #10 round brushes (synthetic or sable), 1" and 2" synthetic flat brushes, 2B pencil and eraser, water container, paper towels, palette, and Graham watercolor paints in these colors: alizarin crimson, raw sienna, cobalt blue, ultramarine blue, Payne's gray. Extended palette includes cad yellow, cad orange, burnt sienna, and quinacridone rose. Experienced watercolorists may bring their usual watercolor supplies. Cost for the two-day workshop is \$100, with a \$50 deposit at sign-up. You may also sign up for one day for \$55. Classroom fee is \$4. All levels of experience are welcome. Class size is limited to 15 students, so please sign up soon.
